Competitor Information

This sheet should be read in conjunction with the Stoneleigh Horse Show May 2021 Schedule.

Grandstand Media Limited and the NAEC Stoneleigh continue to follow Government advice about Coronavirus (COVID-19) and will comply with the latest rules and regulations.

Please note: If you are feeling unwell or experiencing symptoms associated with Coronavirus (COVID-19) you will not be permitted entry to the showground.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Due to the current Covid restrictions, you will only be able to gain entry to the showground with the correct entry and vehicle pass, therefore please ensure you bring them with you.

DOWNLOAD the NHS COVID-19 APP: We are legally required to record all attendees over the age of the 16 on-site during the show. Register on the NHS test and trace app for quick and easy access to the showground. Please note: If you don't register on the app, this may cause a delay in entering the showground. If you do not have a smart phone, you can provide your name and contact details as an alternative.

KEY COVID INFORMATION

Attendance

- Full Covid-19 protocols will be in place.
- Anyone who is symptomatic or suspects they have been exposed to the virus should not take part in any activities and must remain at home.
- A maximum of 3 people may attend the show per horse, this includes the rider.
- No spectating public will be permitted to the showground.

Entries & Stabling

No entries or substitutions will be accepted on the day. Pre-entries only. Only competitors who have pre-booked stabling will be allowed to access the stable area. You will not be able to book any stabling on the day. For competitors stabling it will be necessary to remain in your bubbles and to take all necessary social distancing measures required under the government guidance. This will be monitored and any competitor found to be breaching the social distancing guidelines will be asked to leave the showground. Classes/Competitors

- Class sizes will be monitored as per the Showing Council blueprint for showing, with the exception of WHP classes. Classes may be split.
 - Grooms may only enter the ring at an appropriate time to play their role when indicated by the steward; Grooms should not remain in the ring any longer than is absolutely necessary. Only 1 groom may enter the ring per exhibitor. The groom must wear a face covering at all times when in the ring.
 - In the line up all competitors must remain 2 metres apart.
 - All one way systems on the showground must be adhered to including when returning to the stable area.
 - No equipment should be shared on the day between exhibitors or officials.
 - Competitors are asked to remain in the vicinity of their own lorry when not competing and to leave the showground as soon as possible after the completion of your class and championship.
 - Competitors must take all their litter home due to the risk of contamination.

General

- When social distancing is not possible, face coverings MUST be worn i.e. stewards, medical teams, grooms who do not reside with the rider.
- All people in attendance must check in to Stoneleigh Horse Show using the NHS Track and Trace app – QR codes will be available on arrival and throughout the showground. You are required to scan in the morning if you have overnight stabling.

Equestrian Office/Admin

- The office will be located in the Foreman of the Horse building, access is strictly limited and face coverings must be worn at all times.
- Please note that competitors with horses and/or ponies arriving at NAEC, Stoneleigh Park will ONLY be admitted during the following times:

- No competitor horseboxes or trailers will be allowed entry via the main gate. Please ensure you follow the relevant Road signs.

SHOWING COMPETITORS

Competitor back numbers are included in this pack and must be worn in the ring. For competitors who have multiple entries, please ensure you are wearing the correct number in each class.

VACCINATIONS

It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that the horse's vaccinations are up to date and correctly recorded on the diagrammatic vaccination record. Spot checks will be regularly carried out at shows. The horse/pony must have received two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. Only these two injections need to have been given before a horse/pony can compete in competitions. In addition, a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than

one year apart. Horse/Ponies must have received the full course of vaccinations or the booster at least 7 days prior to the competition date, and not more than 1 year after the previous booster.

STABLING

Stables are booked from 17:00 on the day of arrival until 16:00 on the day of departure from Friday to Sunday. Please note: all stables must be vacated by 18:00 on Sunday 23rd May. Vacated stables must be left in the state they are found.

A deposit of £20 per stable is required, payable by card to the Stable Managers on arrival. This will be refunded on departure following inspection by the Stable Managers to ensure the stable has been left mucked out, clean, tidy and in good repair. Stable deposits not collected at the show will be forfeited.

On arrival, please report to the Stable Manager's Office where you will be given all relevant information and can arrange collection of any pre-ordered bedding. Only SHAVINGS or similar products may be used in stables. **Please note that no bedding will be provided free of charge.**

EXERCISE ARENAS

The external Exercise Areas will only be open during the following times:

Friday 21 st May 2021	17:00 – 20:00
Saturday 22 nd May 2021	07:00 – 20:00
Sunday 23 rd May 2021	07:00 – 18:00

No horse or pony will be allowed into the Competition Arenas for exercise at any time. No horse or pony will be allowed into the external Exercise Areas except at such times as are announced or posted, or as stated in the timetable. If the outside exercise arena is closed, under no circumstances is anyone on the showground permitted to use any arena or other areas on the showground for exercise. Please note that you will only be able to enter the designated warm up area 30 minutes before the start of your class. No access to the warm up area will allowed before this time.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

Emergency services must always have access to the entire show site and attendees must not park vehicles so as to obstruct access. Should you require urgent medical attention please contact your nearest steward or member of the Show Team.

Veterinary cover will be available throughout the show on an on-call basis. Please contact Towcester Vets on 01788 523000.
